Tasks will include but are not limited to :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Compliance <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Comply with regulatory requirements and company manuals and procedures. • Detect and report, hazards and risks associated to the ground activities • Oversight of the safe and careful use of company aircraft during ground operations. • Act as Challenge Airlines (BE) Ground Operations Representative on charter flights when needed. • Special loads <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be responsible for the special loads approval/calculation for Challenge Group. • Identify risks associated to the loading/unloading of oversize cargo. • Ensure Boeing limitations and company regulations are respected during special loads process. • Provide load-ability documents, and tie-down instructions. • Provide support for ground handling providers and commercial teams, with additional documentation such as tie-down sheet, 3D drawings, ... • Trainings and records <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Participate to the development of training contents with the senior loadmaster, aligned with regulatory requirements and best industry practices. • Support Chief Loadmaster to deliver training to ground staff.
